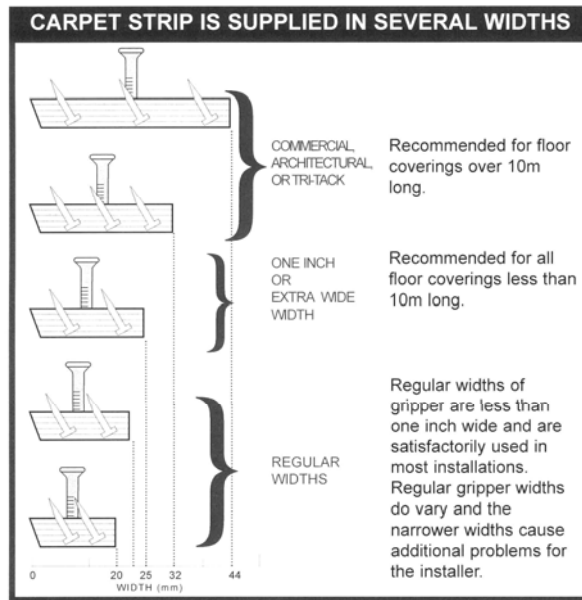

Carpet gripper Types

There are a number of different types of gripper available for use by contractors.

These may make it easier to install difficult, thicker or harder carpets on different thicknesses of underlay



Gripper: 25mm 122Lm per box

Tritack 32mm 85.4 Lm per box

Commercial Tritack 44mm 60 Lm per box

Forms: Wood or Concrete nailed, or Standard (un-nailed)

Also a Box of 120 Lm pieces pre-cut.

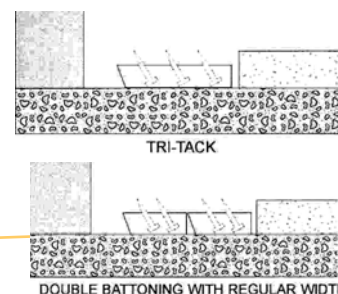
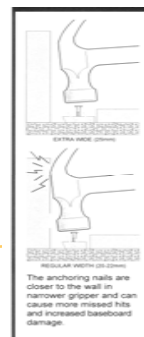
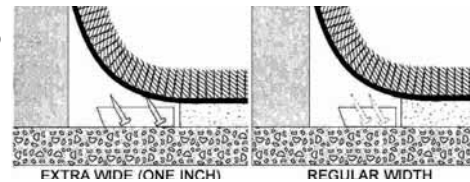
Tri Tack

Nuplex have recently released the Tri-tack Gripper into the NZ market. Why do we think you need it? In Australia, Architectural commercial 44mm (or "Archy as it is known) accounts for over 40% of the carpet gripper sold. Contractors use this product as they have come to value its specific benefits. Tri-tack is the 32mm form of Architectural. Nuplex currently supply Intafloors gripper in the extra wide (25mm) form. Tri-tack is 32mm wide and has three rows of pins. It is available in concrete, wood and standard (un-nailed) forms as usual.

The benefits of Tri-tack are: Best for holding power; particularly on long run commercial carpet. When rounding down the carpet, there is less tendency for the carpet to come off the pins.

- The pins are further from the wall. This makes hooking the carpet easier; particularly with stiff backed carpet over a thick underlay. Tri-tack is even easier than extra wide (as shown).
- As the strip is wider, it is much easier to nail without damaging the wall.

A single strip of TRI-TACK is easier, cheaper and stronger to install than two strips of normal



Carpet Joining

The Kool Glide heat free system This revolutionary system uses inductive heating to bond carpet seams from the carpet surface without damaging the carpet.

A Kool Glide iron and a modified tape are required.
